

# RECITAL DAY – June 16, 2012

All students should plan to return home following their morning run through at the PCPA to eat, rest and get dressed for the recital. If your child's assigned run through finishes after 12:30 p.m. and going home is not reasonable, an adult must remain with your child. If you plan to eat lunch, we ask that you picnic outside on the grass...**eating lunch in the dressing rooms IS NOT permitted!**

**Dressing rooms will not open or be supervised until 30 minutes before show time.**

## 2:00 p.m. SHOW

- Please arrive in costume, ready to dance your 1<sup>st</sup> dance!
- PLEASE DO NOT wait until you arrive at the PCPA to get dressed and/or do your hair & make-up!
- All dancers should arrive by 1:45 p.m.
- Enter through the ARTIST'S ENTRANCE (toward the back side of theater facing Titan Way).
- FIND DRESSING ROOM – All rooms will be marked & there will be volunteers backstage to help you find your way!
- Stay in your dressing area and wait to be given directions for lining up.
- Be kind, be SAFE, stay calm & have FUN!

## 7:00 p.m. SHOW (Same as 2:00 except for the following)

- If you danced in the 2:00 p.m. show, take time between shows to reorganize your costumes and accessories. Make sure you have everything!
- All dancers should arrive by 6:45 p.m.

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Students who dance in only one number in the FIRST HALF of the show may be checked out at intermission. We strongly recommend only Mommies, or other female family members, enter the dressing room area during the show because of the many teenage girls who will be dressing there. Young children will not be permitted to leave the dressing area without an adult at any time during the show!
- If you intend to bring your performer into the theater at any time to watch any portion of the show, **you must purchase a ticket for them.** Dancers must wear a cover up over their costume to enter the theater.
- After the show, children may be picked up on stage or in the dressing area. **Please make sure your child knows where to meet you following the show.**

## VIDEOTAPING/PHOTOGRAPHY

Both the 2:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. shows are being professionally videotaped. Order forms will be available at dress rehearsal on June 2nd as well as in the foyer at the PCPA before and after both shows on June 16th.

The use of personal video cameras is strongly discouraged because of the distraction they can cause to other audience members. If you choose to videotape any portion of the recital, PLEASE be courteous to those around you. Absolutely no video/camera stands will be permitted.

For the safety of your children performing on stage there is **NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY** allowed!
